### NEW NIHB PROGRAM INFORMATION

#### FALL 2007 NIHB DRUG BENEFIT LIST (DBL) UPDATES

The fall DBL updates include the addition and replacement of Drug Identification Numbers (DIN), limited use benefits, drugs removed from the Canadian market, and drugs discontinued by the manufacturer effective October 1, 2007. Copies of these updates are included with this newsletter.

#### REMOVAL OF CLIENT CONSENT WARNING MESSAGE W82

The NIHB warning message **W82 Client Has Not Provided Consent** will no longer appear on the NIHB Pharmacy Claim Statements effective October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2007. The equivalent Canadian Pharmaceutical Association (CPhA) message **HH Client Has Not Provided Consent** will no longer appear on Point-of-Service (POS) claim submission. The removal of this message will not impact claim payments in any way.

### NIHB PROGRAM REMINDERS

#### TERMINATION OF PROVIDER AGREEMENTS

NIHB pharmacy providers should be aware that as part of the regular administrative process, a review of all FCH provider agreements is conducted. As a result, there is a possibility of provider agreements being terminated by FCH on behalf of the Program. Affected providers would be notified in writing 90 days prior to provider agreement termination.

#### QUANTITY LIMITATIONS FOR MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT (MS&E) ITEMS

All MS&E items, with or without prior approval, that have an annual quantity limitation may only be provided and claimed at no more than a three-month period at a time. This is to ensure that benefits provided reflect changes in clients' condition.
